



### **COVID-19 Safety Policy and Procedures – Catamaran and Boat Trips**

The following safety and hygiene measures will be adhered to on all catamaran and boat trips to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission for both customers and staff. These policies and procedures have been put in place using guidelines from the Department of Tourism.

#### **Guests**

- ❖ Any guest who reporting or showing obvious symptoms of COVID-19 will not be allowed to board the boat.
- ❖ Hand sanitizer will be available for guests to use on board.
- ❖ Drinking water will be provided, we encourage guests to bring their own refillable water bottles.

#### **Staff**

- ❖ Staff will wash and sanitize hands regularly.
- ❖ Any staff member presenting symptoms of COVID-19 will be sent home immediately and advised to seek testing prior to returning to work.

#### **During the Trip**

- ❖ A crew member will spray all guest masks with defog solution before entering the water, spitting in masks is not permitted.
- ❖ Kissing stingrays is not permitted at this time.
- ❖ Fresh water showers must be used away from other guests.
- ❖ There will be no rinse buckets available.

#### **Bar**

- ❖ Bar will be regularly sanitized during trip.
- ❖ No re-using of cups.
- ❖ Drink cans will be cleaned with soapy water prior to being packed into the bar.

#### **Boats and equipment**

- ❖ All boat surfaces will be disinfected thoroughly with an EPA approved virucide for use against COVID-19 before and after each trip, and staff will disinfect during trip whenever possible.
- ❖ All rental snorkel equipment will be disinfected thoroughly before and after use and will not be used within 72 hours of being returned.
- ❖ All boats will be equipped with hand sanitizer, sanitizer spray and cleaning wipes.
- ❖ All first aid and medical devices that are not one-time use will be disinfected prior to reopening and after use.
- ❖ Snorkel vests will be sanitized before and after each use, guests will be required to keep their snorkel vest for the duration of their trip.
